








Giant tortoises return to the Galapagos island after nearly 200 years

One hundred and fifty-eight captive-bred juvenile tortoises were released on the island as part of the Floreana Ecological Restoration Project led by the Galápagos National Park Directorate.



Giant tortoises are roaming the Galápagos island of Floreana for the first time in more than 180 years, in what conservationists have called a "hugely significant milestone".



When Charles Darwin set foot on Floreana in 1835, the island's tortoise population was certainly on the brink of collapse. In the preceding decades, Floreana had been a popular port of call for whalers in search of food and they had removed thousands.



The last tortoise to walk on the volcanic slopes of the southerly Galapagos island of Floreana is thought to have died in the 1840s.




The tortoises are not the exact *Chelonoidis* (which went extinct), but rather descendants with high genetic ancestry of the original Floreana tortoises found on Isabela Island.
