Celebration of Reading Week (7th–11th July)

From Monday, 7th July to Friday, 11th July, we will be hosting a *Celebration of Reading Week*, focusing on raising the profile of reading for pleasure across the school. Throughout the week, students will take part in engaging reading activities during lessons, as well as competitions designed to spark their love of books. The week will also include an inspiring activity where students will select a book for a designated *Book Buddy*, based on their responses to a specially designed questionnaire.

Parent's Afternoon – Tuesday, 8th July

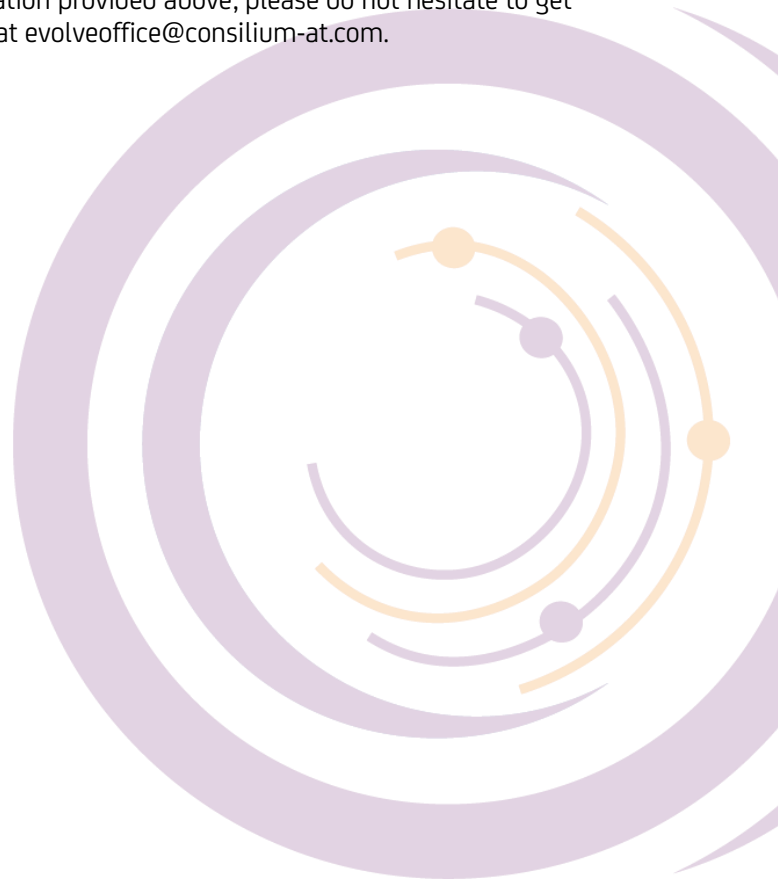
As a reminder, school will finish at 1:00pm on Wednesday, 23rd July. If your child usually travels to and from school via taxi, we will amend the time for this day.
